What the Bill Does

- H.R. 155 does not go far enough in terms of reforming suppressor policy.¹
- Still subjects suppressors to gun registration.

Why it Needs to be Amended

- Still treats firearms accessories like suppressors as firearms.
- Suppressors are still subject to Brady checks, fees, and extra paperwork.
- Other bills like S. 202 are an upgrade to the HPA because they completely deregulate suppressors.
