What the Bill Does

- S. 202 completely de-regulates suppressors.¹
- Removes suppressors from the NFA and treats them like any other firearm accessory; a magazine, stock, grip, scope, flashlight, etc.

Why it's Good for Gun Owners:

- Suppressors would no longer be subject to Brady Checks.
- No more federal regulation which means no extra forms, no law enforcement sign off, no registration, no pictures, no complicated laws to obey.
