What the Bill Does

• Clarifies the legality of interstate transportation of firearms, ammunition, and magazines/feeding devices for ammunition.

Why it's Good for Gun Owners:

- Currently law-abiding gun owners are at risk of fines and imprisonment if they travel from their gun friendly home state through gun hostile states to get to their destination.
- The patchwork of gun laws across the U.S. make it difficult to know what is legal from one state
 to the next. Even legal experts may be unaware of new restrictions and when they are slated to
 go into force in all of the various jurisdictions across the United States.
- H.R. 1680 would bring a measure of protection to those gun owners who are simply attempting to exercise their constitutional right to keep and bear arms while traveling.
