Gun Safety: Not Sorry Act of 2021

What the Bill Does

- Mandate waiting periods for the purchasing of semiautomatic firearms, banning magazines over 10 rounds, banning armor piercing ammunition and imposing waiting periods on silencers (this is in addition to the months it can already take to go through the ATF background check process for silencers.)

Why it's Bad for Gun Owners:

- Senseless waiting periods for purchasing certain guns will not stop mass shootings and will needlessly endanger law-abiding citizens by delaying purchase of a firearm for self-defense
- Banning certain types of ammunition and installing additional hoops for gun owners to go through to obtain a silencer is useless and won't prevent crime.
