### What the Bill Does

- S. 1101 completely deregulates suppressors.<sup>1</sup>
- Removes suppressors from the NFA and treats them like any other firearm accessory; a magazine, stock, grip, scope, flashlight, etc.

### Why it's Good for Gun Owners:

- Suppressors would no longer be subject to Brady Checks
- Suppressors provide an extra layer of hearing protection for gun owners.
- Suppressors can also reduce recoil aiding in accuracy
- No more federal regulation -- which means no extra forms, no law enforcement sign off, no registration, no pictures, no complicated laws to obey
- No more federal regulation also means no \$200 Tax Stamp.
